

You cannot write or edit clauses or comments if you are not signed in.

To sign in, click on the 'Sign in' link at the bottom of the page.


From there, enter your e-mail address and password.

If you see a white header above the web page, you are signed in and can write and edit clauses or comments.

Only sign in from the bloc page of which you are a member.

If you are not a member of a particular bloc, you will not be able to sign in.

Contact your teacher IMMEDIATELY if you are experiencing sign-in problems.



To write a new clause, click on 'Add item' on the left side of the page.

Add Item

The **Clause #** identifies the order of clauses.

When making a new clause, if there are 5 clauses, the next clause # would be '6'.

The **owner** is the name of the country the delegate is representing.

The **description** is the clause wording.

Comments

A clause can be edited by clicking on the clause you want to edit.

Click 'save' to save the edit and return to the page.

Please do not edit the clause # or the Owner.

If you want to combine clauses, delete a clause, or change the clause order (changing the clause #), write a note to the bloc leader in the 'comments'.


